<sup>1</sup> For the reasons stated in *Satellite Healthcare (Santa Rosa)*, 374 NLRB No. 25 (2026), we reject the Employer's contention that the Regional Director lacked the authority to continue processing this petition in the absence of a Board quorum.

In denying review of the Regional Director's overruling of Objection 2, we do not rely on her inadvertent mischaracterization of the Employer's operations (which do not involve "ramp services") or offer of proof (which did not cite safety as a reason it could not communicate with employees during their shifts). Contrary to the Employer's argument, there is no need to remand the case based on these inadvertent mischaracterizations, given that the Regional Director's analysis did not rely on them.

For the reasons set forth in *Satellite Healthcare*, 374 NLRB No. 39 (2026), Members Murphy and Mayer reject the Employer's contention that the election must be set aside because of the Board's holding in *Amazon.com Services*, 373 NLRB No. 136 (2024), an unfair labor practice case. They did not participate in *Amazon* and express no view as to whether it was correctly decided.
