CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AS BONA FIDE
UNDER SECTION 7(b) OF THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT OF 1938

On April 9, 2026, Metropolitan Alliance of Police, Streamwood Civilians, Chapter #567 (the Petitioner) filed with the Regional Director for Region 13 of the National Labor Relations Board a request for certification of representative as bona fide under Section 7(b) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 (FLSA), 29 U.S.C. § 207(b).

On April 22, 2026, the Regional Director for Region 13 served on the parties a Notice to Show Cause why the Board should not grant the request. No response was filed. As the Region's investigation revealed that the Petitioner is the recognized exclusive collective-bargaining representative of the unit employees,¹ the Regional Director recommended to the Board that the requested certification be issued.

No party having shown cause why the requested certification should not be issued, the National Labor Relations Board certifies that Metropolitan Alliance of Police, Streamwood

¹ The record indicates that the Employer is a public sector employer and that the Employer has recognized the Petitioner as the collective-bargaining representative of the unit employees. The recognition is embodied in the terms of the parties' current collective-bargaining agreement, which is effective from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2027.

Civilians, Chapter #567 is a bona fide representative, for purposes of Section 7(b) of the FLSA, of the employees in the following unit:²

All full-time and regular part-time non-sworn employees of the Streamwood Police Department in the following job classifications: community service officer; parking/code enforcement aide; and police services specialist, but excluding any other sworn, managerial, confidential, or supervisory employees of the Streamwood Police Department.

² A certificate of representative as bona fide for purposes of the FLSA does not necessarily establish the certified organization's right to be recognized as the exclusive bargaining representative under the provisions of the National Labor Relations Act. See *County of Alameda*, 322 NLRB 614 (1996).
