<sup>1</sup> Cf. *Tekweld Solutions, Inc.*, 361 NLRB 201, 201-203 (2014). We agree with the Regional Director's finding that the Employer's motion to revoke, or withdraw from, the parties' agreed-upon eligibility date is beyond the terms of the Stipulated Election Agreement which, we emphasize, expressly contemplated the possibility that the election would need to be rescheduled, but did not provide for a change in the eligibility date. The circumstances of this case are not sufficiently "unusual" nor they do they amount to the "cause" to warrant that the voter eligibility date in the Stipulated Election Agreement be set aside. See *T&L Leasing*, 318 NLRB 324, 325 (1995).
